Discipline Policy A camper will be sent home upon receiving notice of a third infraction of unacceptable behavior. Two written warnings must be given with signatures of the camper, counselor, and weekly camp director. After a second warning, the parents or guardian of the camper will be notified that their son/daughter will be sent home if one more incident occurs. Some blatant behaviors will receive no warning but, upon the decision of the camp director, will warrant the camper's immediate dismissal. Parents/guardians will be notified, and they will be responsible for the removal of the camper. In the event the parent cannot pick up the camper, the camp director will assign someone to take the camper home at the expense of the parent at the rate of 50.5 cents per mile. PARENTS, READ TOO PLEASE.

Bible-based fun!

Camp Utmost is located in the beautiful Blackfoot River valley. A well-trained staff serves at the camp. They are there because they love Christ and the children. The Bible and campers are our focus and joy. In addition to lessons and chapel, campers will enjoy many activities such as hiking, swimming, archery, rafting, canoeing, rifle marksmanship, crafts, and campfire. All activities are age appropriate and well supervised.

What do I need to bring and do?

Campers need to bring a warm sleeping bag, pillow, extra blanket, flashlight with extra batteries, water bottle, water shoes, and shoes for daily use. Clothes should include warm sleepwear, jeans, sweatshirts, rain gear, and a coat. Dress conservatively: no two-piece swimsuits, no spaghetti string tank tops (cover the shoulders and midriff), no short-shorts. Any clothing with words deemed inappropriate is subject to confiscation.

Necessary toiletries may include towels, washcloths, soap, toothpaste and brush, hair comb and brush, shampoo, Chap Stick (or a similar product), sunscreen, insect repellent, and bee sting kit (if prescribed by a doctor.) You will also need a notebook, pen or pencil, and your Bible.

What time do I come and go?

Grade school campers should arrive by 11:00 am on Monday and should depart by noon on the last day of camp. (Please note that 4-5th and 6th grade camps end on Friday; 7th through 9th grade camps end on Saturday.)

High school campers arrive by 6:00 pm (in time for the evening meal) on Friday and depart by noon on Monday.

How much does it cost?

Registration fees are due in full by the pre-registration deadline. If paying after the deadline, registration is \$10 more. These fees cover the entire week of housing, meals, and activities. (There are a limited number of scholarships available, please call the Mission office—532-1565—for more information.)

Camp Utmost has a store that sells food treats, drinks, and clothing items. Campers must let the store personnel keep their spending money for them. (Ten to fifteen dollars is sufficient for a camper's store money.) Parents are welcome to pre-pay T-shirts and for their child's snacks. Any money not spent will be returned to the camper the last day of his/her camp.

Which camp should I attend?

The camp experience is designed to be age appropriate for the grade the camper is entering. For example, if you will be entering eighth grade in the fall, you attend the 8th Grade week of camp. High school camp is only for those entering 10th to 12th grades.

What do I need to leave at home?

Do not bring magazines, cell phones, electronic devices, alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, fireworks, firearms, and knives. Also, do not bring any food to camp; there is a hazard of animals seeking treats!

What not to do:

- Mess with someone else's personal belongings.
- Wander off camp property.
- Be alone with a person of the opposite sex.

- Registration form completed, fees enclosed, and mailed as early as possible.

- Spending money for camper included. This is optional, but if sent with the child for safety and security it will be deposited at the camp store for your camper's use.
- If transportation arrangements change, you must inform the camp director prior to pickup. Call the camp at (406) 244-0049, please.
- Include the \$10 (roundtrip) or \$10 (one-way) bus transportation fee, if applicable.
- The camp keeps lost and found items only for two weeks. After that, we donate useable items to Goodwill or the Salvation Army.

\$ Camp Refund Policies

An 80% refund is made if notice is given to the Mission by the pre-registration deadline of that camp.

A 50% refund is made if notice is given to the Mission office no later than the beginning of that camp.

No refund will be made once the camp starts.

All refunds are processed after the camp ends.

We cannot prorate fees for attending only a part of the camp week.

🚌 Bus Transportation

We provide campers with bus transportation. The fee is only \$10 for the round trip or \$10 for one way.
